

Scientific Poster Information

EFIB 2010 is an ideal opportunity to present a scientific poster alongside an extensive exhibition covering new IB products and processes. This event will ensure your work is seen by the most influential leaders in the field. Postdocs and PhD students are eligible to participate in the conference poster session and can also benefit from a special academic rate.

How to apply

Register for the conference at the special academic rate and [email us <insert link>](#) your contact details, including your full name, academic status and name of university and attach your abstract for review.

We will acknowledge your application and let you know if your abstract is accepted. Then all you need to do is make sure you register for the conference and follow the poster session instructions.

Poster session instruction

Format and display:

- One panel side per poster is provided for display
- Posters must be of A0 format - 840 [width] x 1180 mm [length]
- Poster must be in the portrait orientation (upright)
- Paragraphs are laid out horizontally
- A copy of the abstract (in large type) must be incorporated into the poster, alternatively a copy of the abstract may be attached to the upper left-hand corner of the panel
- All poster panels will be numbered. Please note your poster number before you deliver it to ensure proper placement of your poster.

A title section at the top of the poster must contain:

- Title of the poster
- All authors
- Author's affiliations

Schedule:

- Scientific posters may be viewed throughout the coffee breaks, lunches and during the evening receptions
- Poster set-up will be arranged by the conference organisers (IntertechPira) before the evening conference session and reception on the first day
- If you are unable to deliver your poster in time for the set-up, please ensure it is delivered by 7.30 am the day before
- Poster removal is from 6.30 to 7.30 pm on the last day
- All posters must be removed by 7.30 pm, or they will be discarded
